In this constantly progressing World, there are places that still exist which are wild & untouched as a reminder of ageless wonder & beauty.

Jamoon is situated on the banks of River Ramganga, nestled amidst deep dense Sal forest, and located at the edge of Corbett Tiger Reserve in the foothills of Himalayas. It is inspired by local tradition and based on the principle of minimalism.

Jamoon derives its name from a local evergreen tropical tree – Malabar plum or Jamun (*Syzygium cumini*). It is a pristine & untamed secret treasure of Corbett, waiting to be discovered.

### NATURE WALKS

Find bliss as you walk along the serene Ramganga river. A beautiful experience, especially during the winter months.

### WALKING SAFARIS

Take off on one of the many trails along the River Ramganga, the lifeline of Corbett. Our naturalists accompany you to offer insight on the myriad experiences you have along the way.

### BIRDWATCHING OVER 400 + SPECIES OF BIRDS

The most exotic species are permanent residents at The Jamoon. Wake up to the beautiful sound of them chirping, and even capture them candidly through our Hide photography set up, while you sit comfortably in an armchair.

### REMOTE AND CAMERA TRAP PHOTOGRAPHY

We have our own cameras, which guests can use to capture elusive cats and other wildlife.

### HIDE PHOTOGRAPHY

We have our own little waterhole that is frequented by creatures both of day and night. Our hide overlooking the waterhole can give you great captures without being too intrusive.

### NATURE'S SMALL WONDERS

Home to nature's small wonders like insects, reptiles and amphibians, the place is teeming with life.

### PUGMARK CASTING

If you are a wildlife enthusiast, tracking pug marks may be of interest to you. If you do find some, you could cast the pugmark using POP and take it home as a souvenir.

### STARGAZING & NIGHTSKY PHOTOGRAPHY

A night spent under the star studded sky at Jamoon is an experience you will remember for a lifetime. With no electricity around the area, the entire place is lit up with star light.

### BONFIRE EVENINGS

Spend evenings at the Jamoon, under starlit skies and a campfire, listening to the sounds of the wild and tales of tigers.

Deep in the heart of the forest, this is your doorway to the unexplored extreme wilderness. It is one place where time or schedule does not intrude; you choose the adventure you want to be a part of – go tracking tigers or laze by the gurgling river, follow a trodden trail or eke out your own, listen to jungle tales or write your own.

Our skilled and seasoned Naturalists help you explore flora and fauna around the lodge while being disconnected from the world. You can enjoy raw nature and enhance your skills through diverse opportunities using our finely crafted experiences.



## Traditional Accommodation

There are 5 permanent Swiss Cottage tents with en-suite toilets in 10 acres which are cosy and comfortable. The lodge is lit with own solar lights & lanterns and fenced.

While care is taken to see that you are comfortable, we have also gone the extra mile to see that nothing is compromised from your lodge experience. Only sound you will hear is the chirping of birds, crickets and alarm calls.



## Food Experience

All food is freshly cooked in the lodge kitchen and we bring you the local flavours. As special treats, we also organize for jungle themed meals and barbecues around bonfire.

Relish 'Pahadi' style of cooking, with food cooked on traditional earthen chulhas. Experience the concept of Bush dinner with meat and vegetables cooked using Elephant Grass.



## Sustainable Tourism

Jamoon was envisaged to preserve the wildlife that inhabits the region while collaborating with local communities, preserving the local heritage, providing employment opportunities and promoting sustainable tourism.
