It is inspired by local tradition and based on the principle of minimalism. Jamoon derives its name from a local evergreen tropical tree - Malabar plum or Jamun (Syzygium cumini). It is a pristine & untamed secret treasure of Corbett, waiting to be discovered.

### **BONFIRE EVENINGS**


Spend evenings at the Jamoon, under starlit skies and a campfire, listening to the sounds of the wild and tales of tigers.




## Traditional Accommodation

There are 5 permanent Swiss Cottage tents with en-suite toilets in 10 acres which are cosy and comfortable. The lodge is lit with own solar lights & lanterns and fenced.

While care is taken to see that you are comfortable, we have also gone the extra mile to see that nothing is compromised from your lodge experience. Only sound you will hear is the chirping of birds, crickets and alarm calls.
