A backdrop to some of the world's greatest hunting stories, India's Corbett National Park is not an ordinary stretch of conserved wilderness. It is the stuff that legends are made of, it is the land of Jim Corbett, it is the home of one of the most awe-inspiring beasts – the Tiger – and of other animals and birds you probably have heard of only in stories. It is the place for brave hearts and curious feet, the place where Nature is both exotic and wild. It is where adventures are born everyday and where you will step in to one almost before you know it.

Jamoon is no ordinary wildlife lodge. Spread over 10 acres in a cluster of premium cottage - tented accommodation, it is at a stone's throw away from the River Ramganga, which is the life-line of Corbett National Park. Jamoon, derives it's name from a local evergreen tropical tree – Malabar plum or Jamun (*Syzygium cumini*).



Jamoon is the place for brave hearts and curious feet, it is the place where Nature is both exotic and wild. This is a mysterious and untouched secret treasure of Corbett, waiting to be discovered.

# Nature Walks

*Himalayan river is right here – go for a swim on a warm morning. Watch the fish in the clear water. This is a place to enjoy solitude. If you are a Nature Photo enthusiast you might want to capture the surreal nature of the river during dawn and dusk.*

Experience nature walks along the Ramganga river. Feel the blissful and serene nature of the Ramganga when the winter fog rises up and the sun pierces through the mist to create a magical atmosphere. Watch the river reveal itself as the fog slowly vanishes into the air. This winter fog of Corbett offers some amazing photo moments.



## Bird - Watching

*If you are a bird-watching enthusiast, you will be in a paradise. You can spot some rare Himalayan birds like the beautiful 'Common Green Magpie' or the shy 'Maroon Oriole'. The Ramganga river offers regular sightings of 'Forktails', 'Redstarts', & 'Kingfishers'. You may want to grab a pair of binoculars or a camera to capture the avian diversity of Corbett.*

Wake up to the sound of birds at Jamoon. There are more than 400 species of birds in and around the lodge, some of which are permanent residents of the lodge. Capture the winged wonders of Kumaon to your hearts content. We also have an in-house Bird Photography Hide, where you can photograph rare Himalayan birds through the blinds by sitting back on your armchair.

# Walking Safaris

*Not many places in India, can you experience walking on foot inside the Jungle. Following the footsteps of Jim Corbett, you may be walking on the trails used by Tigers, Leopards and Elephants.*

Jamoon is located deep in the forest, on the banks of River Ramganga, which is the lifeline of the region. We have plenty of trails alongside the river which can be explored on foot for amazing wildlife opportunities. You are accompanied by our skilled naturalists who guide you through the terrain and ensure safety & security of the guests.



## Remote & Camera-Trap Photography

*The Jamoon Team has identified trails where guests can install their cameras to photograph elusive animals. Big Cats, Small Cats, Deer, Primates, Rodents, Pachyderms, Avifauna - You have a wide variety of species to capture on your trap setups.*

Jamoon has its own trail cameras which can be deployed by the guests to capture elusive cats and other wildlife. If you wish you can also deploy your own DSLR camera traps or Trail cameras within the vicinity our lodge to get unique perspective of Wildlife.

# Hide Photography

*Photography Hides are built, so that guests can view and capture wildlife without disturbing them. Sitting inside a hide, observing wildlife at close quarters and knowing that only a wall separates the viewer from the wild animal is an adventure in itself.*

Jamoon has its own private waterhole, frequented by creatures of day and night. Sit around and enjoy nature at its most raw form. Get up-close and personal with wildlife by experiencing hide photography through our own hide overlooking the waterhole and capture behaviour of birds, mammals and reptiles without disturbing them.



## Nature's Small Wonders

*Corbett National Park is a home to more than 30 reptile species including the largest venomous snake in the world - 'The King Cobra'. It also houses many species of insects, butterflies, spiders and amphibians. Jamoon offers you many opportunities to explore these lesser known fauna of India throughout your stay.*

Jamoon is located deep inside the forest of Corbett National Park, which is not just a haven for big mammals and birds, but also a home to the nature's small wonders like Insects, Reptiles, Amphibians and many mysterious creatures. You can come and explore a land, teeming with life in all corners.



# Star-Gazing & Night Sky Photography

*We've heard the legends inspired by constellations and we know sailors used the stars to guide their way home, but urban light pollution means we can't quite see the heavens ourselves. The best way to start exploring the night sky is with the unaided eye. After all there is a universe out there to explore!*

Only in few places in India, can you experience the true beauty of dark skies illuminated by stars. Spend a night under this star-studded sky at Jamoon, who knows maybe you even discover a new star or a constellation. Since there is no electricity in and around the lodge, the entire campus is lit with only the stars shining above.



## Bonfire Evenings

*The Corbett landscape is set on a backdrop of World's greatest hunting stories told by sir Jim Corbett. It is land of one of the awe-inspiring beasts - The Tiger. Listen to these stories from the Naturalist and the locals of the region as you seek the warmth of fire.*

Evenings at Jamoon are spent under a starlit sky, with a camp-fire to keep you warm as we serve barbequed snacks, amidst valley that reverberates with tales of tigers unfolding over a crackling fire, as you witness sounds from the wild.





# Accommodation

Jamoon consists of -

- 5 Luxury Cottage Tents with attached toilet and bath, bedroom and private verandah

- The Gol-ghar - An open air restaurant with the views of nature for an elegant dining experience

- An open lawn surrounding the cottages for recreational purposes

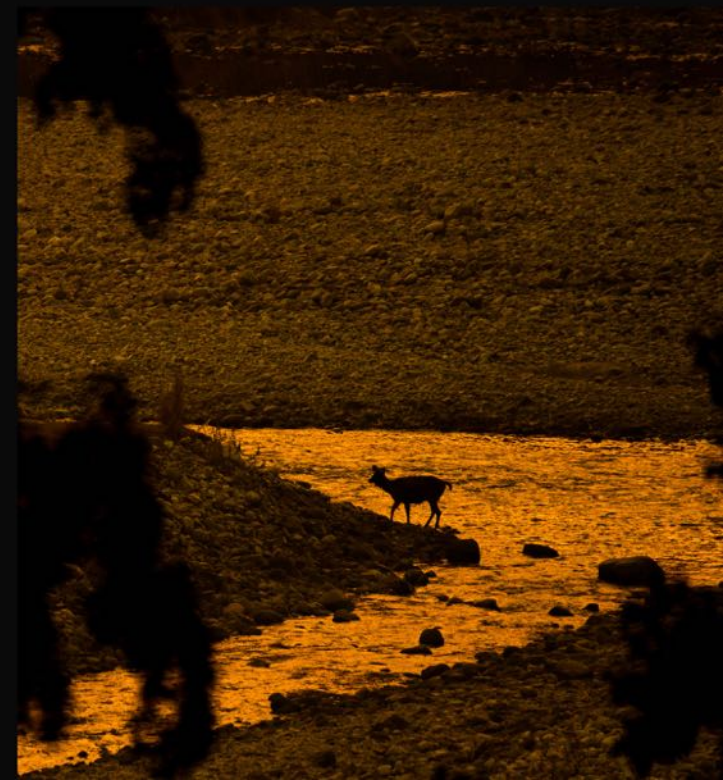
Jamoon is remotely located and completely isolated from chaos of outside world.

# How to get to Jamoon

Guests have to reach The Riverview Retreat, a luxury resort located on the fringes of Corbett National Park, and will be transferred to Jamoon by 4WD Jeeps next morning. The Lodge is accessible only on foot from the drop-off point at village Basedi. One has to trek 3.5 kms with some inclines and declines to reach the lodge. The accessibility to The Riverview Retreat is -

**By Air :** Phoolbagh in Pantnagar, 50-kms away from the resort is the nearest airport. Delhi that lies 260 kms away from the national park is the nearest international airport.

**By Rail :** Ramnagar is the nearest railway station from where the taxi or bus can be availed to reach the resort. There is a direct train from Delhi to Ramnagar via Moradabad.

**By Road :** The Riverview Retreat is located at a distance of 260 km. from Delhi and is conveniently connected by road. The tourists can also follow the route from Delhi -Hapur-Moradabad-Ramnagar. The Corbett National Park and The Riverview Retreat are easily accesible from Lucknow and Ramnagar is served by frequent buses to and from various tourist places in India.





# Sustainable Tourism

Jamoon was envisaged to preserve the wildlife that inhabits the region while collaborating with local communities, preserving the local heritage, providing employment opportunities and promoting sustainable tourism. It is an eco-conscious Lodge and it believes in green energy sources to run itself on a day-to day basis. It also empowers the villagers by procuring local produce from surrounding hamlets.





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
